

**Candidates for Superior Court Judge
Presidential Primary Election
March 5, 2024**

This calendar is intended to be a general-purpose resource for those seeking information for the Presidential Primary Election on March 5, 2024. We have tried to make it as useful and accurate as possible, but it should not be relied upon in place of the Elections and/or Government Codes for statutory guidance.

<p>September 14 – November 8, 2023</p> <p>E-173 – E-118</p>	<p>Signatures in Lieu of Filing Fees</p> <p>During this period, candidates may obtain signature-in-lieu forms from the Humboldt County Office of Elections, 2426 6th Street, Eureka, to secure signatures in lieu of paying all or part of the filing fee. The forms must be turned in by November 8, 2023, at 5PM.</p> <p>Within 10 days after receipt of a petition, the elections official shall notify the candidate of any deficiency. The judicial candidate shall then, at the time of declaring intent, pay a pro rata portion of the filing fee to cover the deficiency.</p> <p>Signatures-in-lieu will also be counted as nomination signatures.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8061-8063, 8105-8106</p>
<p>October 30 – November 8, 2023</p> <p>E-127 – E-118</p>	<p>Declaration of Intention – Judicial Candidates</p> <p>During this period, judicial candidates file their declarations of intention with the Office of Elections to become a candidate for office.</p> <p>The nonrefundable filing fee is due when the declaration is filed. Payment can be made, in part or wholly, using signature in lieu petitions.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8023, 8104, 8105(b)</p>
<p>November 9 – November 13, 2023</p> <p>E-117 – E-113</p>	<p>Extension of Declaration of Intention Period – Judicial Candidates</p> <p>If an incumbent for the office has not filed a Declaration of Intention by November 8, 2023, a five-day extension will become effective allowing non-incumbents to file a Declaration of Intention.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8023(b)</p>
<p>November 13 – December 8, 2023</p> <p>E-113 – E-88</p>	<p>Nomination Period</p> <p>During this period, judicial candidates can pick up nomination forms at the Office of Elections. Nomination papers are due back to the Office of Elections by December 8, 2023, at 5PM.</p> <p>Candidates for Superior Court Judge must collect at least 20 and no more than 40 nomination signatures.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8020, 8060-8069, 8106(d)</p>

<p>November 13 – December 8, 2023</p> <p>E-113 – E-88</p>	<p>Declaration of Candidacy Period</p> <p>During this period, all candidates must file their declarations of candidacy along with their candidate statements of qualifications if they choose to submit one. Forms are obtained from and filed with the Humboldt County Office of Elections.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8020, 8040, 8064, 8100</p>
<p>November 13 – December 8, 2023</p> <p>E-113 – E-88</p>	<p>NO Withdrawal of Candidacy</p> <p>No candidate whose declaration of candidacy has been filed for any primary election may withdraw as a candidate at that primary election.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8800</p>
<p>December 6, 2023 – March 5, 2024</p> <p>E-90 – E</p>	<p>24-Hour contribution reporting period begins (FPPC Forms 496/497)</p> <p>During the 90 days immediately preceding an election and including Election Day, the following contributions that total in the aggregate of \$1,000 or more must be reported within 24 hours to the county elections official.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 496: File if independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more are made. • 497: File if a contribution of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate is received from a single source. • 497: File if a contribution of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate is made to a candidate or measure being voted upon March 5, 2024, or to a political party committee. • The recipient of a non-monetary contribution of \$1,000 or more must file a Form 497 report within 48 hours from the time the contribution is received. File by personal delivery, e-mail, guaranteed overnight service, fax or online, if available. <p style="text-align: right;">Gov. Code 82036</p>
<p>December 9 - December 13, 2023</p> <p>E-87 – E-83</p>	<p>Extension of Nomination Period</p> <p>For Judicial offices, if the incumbent of the office files a Declaration of Intention, but for any reason fails to qualify for nomination for the office by December 8, an additional five days shall be allowed for the filing of nomination papers for the office. Any person, other than the incumbent if otherwise qualified, may file nomination papers for the office during the extended period, notwithstanding that he or she has not filed by November 8 a written and signed Declaration of Intention to become a candidate for the office.</p> <p>NOTE: This extension does NOT apply...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) when the incumbent for judicial office does not file a Declaration of Intention for that same office (there is an earlier filing extension period from November 9 to November 13); 2) when there is no incumbent eligible to be re-elected. <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8024, 8204</p>
<p>December 9 – December 13, 2023</p> <p>E-87 – E-83</p>	<p>Extension of Declaration of Candidacy Period</p> <p>Extension period for anyone other than the incumbent to file a declaration of candidacy and nomination documents if the incumbent did not file by December 8, 2023. This provision does not apply if there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8024</p>

<p>December 18, 2023</p> <p>(E-78)</p>	<p>Write-in Campaign Judicial Offices</p> <p>Last day to file a petition indicating that a write-in campaign will be conducted against an unopposed superior court judicial candidate who has filed Nomination Papers. Write-in candidates must file between January 8 and February 20.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC 8203(a), 8600-8604</p>
<p>January 25, 2024</p> <p>E-40</p>	<p>First pre-election campaign statement (460/470) due.</p> <p>Last day to file campaign statements for candidates and committees covering the period ending January 20, 2024.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Gov. Code 84200.5, 84200.8</p>
<p>February 22, 2024</p> <p>E-14</p>	<p>Second pre-election campaign statement (460) due.</p> <p>Last day to file campaign statements for candidates and committees covering the period from January 21, 2024, to February 17, 2024.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Gov. Code 84200.5, 84200.8</p>
