Get Ready for the Uniform District Election

The Humboldt County Office of Elections encourages Garberville Fire Protection District voters to get prepared for the upcoming Uniform District Election on Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

The Uniform District Election will be held only for Humboldt County voters who live in the Garberville Fire Protection District.

How to Vote in the November 7 Uniform District Election

Garberville Fire Protection District voters may vote safely at home and return vote-by-mail ballots in the following ways:

- Mail it on or before Election Day, no postage is required.
- Drop it off in-person Tuesday, November 7.

Polling places for the Uniform District Election will be located at the SoHum Health Garberville Campus, located at 286 Sprowel Creek Road, Garberville, CA.

On the day of the election, the polling place will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. At the polling place, voters can:

- Vote using accessible voting machines.
- Receive translation services in 72 languages.
- Get a replacement ballot.
- Drop off a vote-by-mail ballot.
- Vote on a precinct ballot.
- Update voter registration.
- Conditionally register to vote.
- Vote on a provisional ballot.

Voters who have received a vote-by-mail ballot who wish to vote in-person must bring their vote-by-mail ballot to surrender so they can vote using a precinct ballot.

Logic and Accuracy Testing for the Uniform District Election

The Humboldt County Office of Elections will conduct logic and accuracy testing of the county's voting machines on Tuesday, October 3 at 2 p.m. Prior to each election, the Office of Elections tests ballots and equipment to ensure that all ballot types are read correctly and all ballot counting equipment is fully functional and tallying votes accurately. A specific Logic and Accuracy Observer

Panel of no more than two will be convened, pursuant to the California Secretary of State's approved logic and accuracy procedures, to certify the validity and outcome of the testing. The Logic and Accuracy Testing is open to the public. If you wish to attend be at the Elections Office, no later than 1:50 p.m. to be signed in through security.
