Humboldt County Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) can provide you the support and services you need to achieve recovery from substance use disorder (SUD).

We provide SUD treatment to Medi-Cal beneficiaries who meet medical necessity for outpatient and intensive outpatient levels of care.

We have SUD treatment programs for adults, adolescents and pregnant and/or parenting individuals who identify as women.

Adult Services

Services Humboldt County Programs for Recovery (HCPR) assists individuals who are experiencing substance use problems that are impacting their physical health, interpersonal relationships or causing employment or legal issues.

Youth Services

The Adolescent Treatment Program (ATP) utilizes evidence-based practices from a variety of approaches designed to best meet the needs of youth experiencing substance use disorder(s) (SUD), including mild, moderate and/or severe SUD. ATP is available to provide outpatient services to youth ages 12 to 18 years old.

Perinatal Services

Healthy Moms Program (HMP) is a substance use disorder treatment program that assists participants in treating their addictions and supporting them to become healthy, productive women and mothers. Childcare is provided on-site for children under the age of 6 years old.

How to apply

Call or come to a program location to pick up an admission packet or have one sent to you. Fill out the packet and return it prior to or during your SUD assessment.

Call Carelon Behavioral Health to complete a brief screening and connect with a SUD treatment provider who offers the level of care that fits your needs. DHHS staff will connect with you during the call to schedule an assessment should you be referred to DHHS's Humboldt County Programs for Recovery.
