## Presidential Primary Election

### March 5, 2024

This calendar is intended to be a general-purpose resource for those seeking information for the Presidential Primary Election on March 5, 2024. We have tried to make it as useful and accurate as possible, but it should not be relied upon in place of the Elections and/or Government Codes for statutory guidance.

<p><b>December 8, 2023</b></p> <p><b>E-88</b></p>	<p><b>Submit Resolutions of Consolidation</b></p> <p><b>Last day</b> for the governing body of a district, city, school or other political subdivision to file a request for consolidation with the March 2024 election with the Humboldt County Office of Elections. Copy sent to the Board of Supervisors. <b>We encourage jurisdictions planning to have a measure on the ballot to contact the Office of Elections early in the process.</b></p> <p>Whenever resolutions calling for a measure to be placed on the ballot are filed, immediately after that filing date there will be a 10-day public inspection period. Documents will be on public display at the Office of Elections, 2426 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Eureka. During this period, any voter of the jurisdiction or the county elections official may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9190, 9380, 10401, 10402, 10403</p>
<p><b>December 8, 2023</b></p> <p><b>E-88</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline for Tax Rate Statement for Bond Measure</b></p> <p>Last day to file tax rate statement for any bond measure appearing on the March ballot. This statement is filed with the Office of Elections.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9401</p>
<p><b>December 13, 2023</b></p> <p><b>E-83</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline to File Arguments for Measures</b></p> <p>Arguments for or against any measure called for the election are due by 5 p.m. at the Office of Elections. Arguments are public after the deadline. Arguments shall not exceed 300 words.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9162, 9163, 9316</p>
<p><b>December 14 – 26, 2023</b></p> <p><b>E-82 to E-70*</b></p> <p>*(Extended for the Christmas Holiday)</p>	<p><b>10-day Public Inspection for Arguments</b></p> <p>10-calendar day public inspection of arguments filed by December 13, 2023. During the public examination period, any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the county elections official, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the public examination period.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9190, 9380</p>
<p><b>December 20, 2023</b></p> <p><b>E-76</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline for Filing Rebuttals and Analyses of Measures</b></p> <p>Rebuttals to arguments for and against will be due by 5pm. Rebuttals are public after the deadline. Rebuttals shall not exceed 250 words.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9167, 9317</p>

	<p>County Counsel to submit analysis for county and school/special district measures; City attorney to submit analysis of city measures. Analysis shall not exceed 500 words.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9160, 9280, 9313</p> <p>County auditor, if previously directed by the board of supervisors, to submit fiscal analysis of measures. Analysis shall not exceed 500 words.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9160</p>
<p><b>December 20, 2023 - January 2, 2024</b></p> <p><b>E-76 to E-63</b></p>	<p><b>10-day Public Inspection for Rebuttals and Analyses</b></p> <p>10-calendar day public inspection of rebuttals and analysis to arguments filed by December 20, 2023. During the public examination period, any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the county elections official, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the public examination period.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">EC9190, 9380</p>
<p><b>December 29, 2023</b></p>	<p><b>Print Deadline</b></p> <p>The County Elections office has set this deadline. All materials needed to appear in the County Voter Information Guide or on the Ballot must be in the Office of Elections by 5pm this date.</p>
<p><b>MARCH 5, 2024</b></p>	<p><b>ELECTION DAY</b></p>

Filing by Fax or Email: Signatures on arguments, rebuttals and analyses must appear on the same page as the text of the argument, rebuttal, or analysis. Original signatures must be presented to the elections official within 48 hours of the electronic transmission or the item(s) will not be considered as filed (weekends and holidays excepted). Electronic transmission must be started prior to 5 p.m. on deadline days to be accepted as filed. The fax number is 707-445-7204. Confidentiality: Arguments, rebuttals and analyses shall remain confidential until 5 p.m. on the date they are due.
