RESOLUTION NO. 73-30

ESTABLISHING TRINIDAD SCENIC DRIVE
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, by notice dated January 24, 1973, a public hearing was called for February 27, 1973, at the hour of 1:45 p.m., in the Supervisors' Chambers in the Courthouse, Eureka, California, to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety, or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service, within that certain area of the County described as follows:

Beginning at a point that is the intersection of the North line of Section 36, T.8 N., R.1 W., H.B.& M., and the Mean High Tide Line of the Pacific Ocean;

Thence East 750 feet more or less to the center of Luffenholtz Creek;

Thence in a Southwesterly direction along the center of Luffenholtz Creek to a point 50 feet Easterly of the Easterly right of way line of Trinidad Scenic Drive (County Road No. 4M310), said right of way described more particularly in the Plan of the Proposed State Highway in Humboldt County, from Mad River to Trinidad, on file in Book 3 of Highway Maps, Pages 37 to 59, in the Office of the Recorder, County of Humboldt;

Thence parallel to, and 50 feet easterly of said right of way, running in a Southeasterly direction 6,706 feet more or less to the South line of Section 31, T.8 N., R.1 E., H.B.& M.;

Thence S 0° 01' 49" W 80 feet;

Thence N 89° 58' 11" W parallel to the South line of said Section 31, to the Mean High Tide Line of the Pacific Ocean;

Thence in a Northwesterly direction along the Mean High Tide Line to the intersection with the westerly prolongation of that line common to Lots 7 and 8 of the Moonstone Beach subdivision, recorded in Book 11 of Maps, Pages 6 and 7, in the Office of the Recorder, County of Humboldt;

Thence East 600 feet more or less to the Southeast corner of the parcel of land, conveyed to William A. and Patricia B. Wooten, from H. R. V. and Ruth B. Chapman, recorded February 29, 1968, in Book 952 Official Records, Page 334, in the Office of the Recorder, County of Humboldt;

Thence along the East property line of said parcel to the Northwest corner of Lot 14, in said subdivision;

Thence North 120 feet, to the Northwest corner of Lot 15, in said subdivision;

Thence West 100 feet, to the Northwest corner of Lot 16, in said subdivision;

Thence North 100 feet, to the Northwest corner of Lot 23, in said subdivision;

Thence North along a prolongation of the West line of Lot 23, 20 feet;

Thence Northwesterly 150 feet more or less to the Southwest corner of Lot 28 in said subdivision;

Thence N 32° 30' 00" W 100 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 29, in said subdivision;

Thence Northeasterly along the South line of Lot 29, to a point lying 50 feet westerly of the westerly right of way line of Trinidad Scenic Drive;

Thence parallel to and 50 feet westerly of said right of way, running in a northwesterly direction to a point on the South line of Lot 7, Block 10, Westhaven Subdivision, recorded in Book 11 of Maps, Pages 19 to 22, in the Office of the Recorder, County of Humboldt;

Thence along the south line of said Lot 7, in a Westerly direction to the Mean High Tide Line of the Pacific Ocean;

Thence in a Northwesterly direction along the Mean High Tide Line of the Pacific Ocean, to the Point of Beginning.

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given to all affected property owners as such are shown on the last equalized assessment roll and to all utilities concerned in the manner and within the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held, and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt that, pursuant to Ordinance No. 652 of the County of Humboldt, the above-described area is hereby declared an underground utility district and is designated as Trinidad Scenic Drive Underground Utility District No. 1 of the County of Humboldt. Attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A," and hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution, is a map delineating the boundaries of said District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors does hereby fix July 1, 1974, as the date on which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service, and does hereby order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service within Trinidad Scenic Drive Underground Utility District No. 1 on or before September 1, 1974.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk is hereby instructed to notify all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within the Trinidad Scenic Drive Underground Utility District No. 1 of the adoption of this resolution within ten (10) days after the date of such adoption. Said County Clerk shall further notify said property owners of the necessity that, if they or any person occupying such property desire to continue to receive electric, communication, or other similar or associated service, they or such occupant shall, by the date fixed in this resolution,

provide all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive such services from the lines of the supplying utility or utilities at a new location, subject to applicable rules, regulations, and tariffs of the respective utility or utilities on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. Such notification shall be made by publishing once in a newspaper of general circulation a copy of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines as follows:

The Trinidad Scenic Drive Underground Utility District No. 1 herein created is in the general public interest for the following reason: The said road adjoins or passes through an area of unusual scenic interest to the general public.

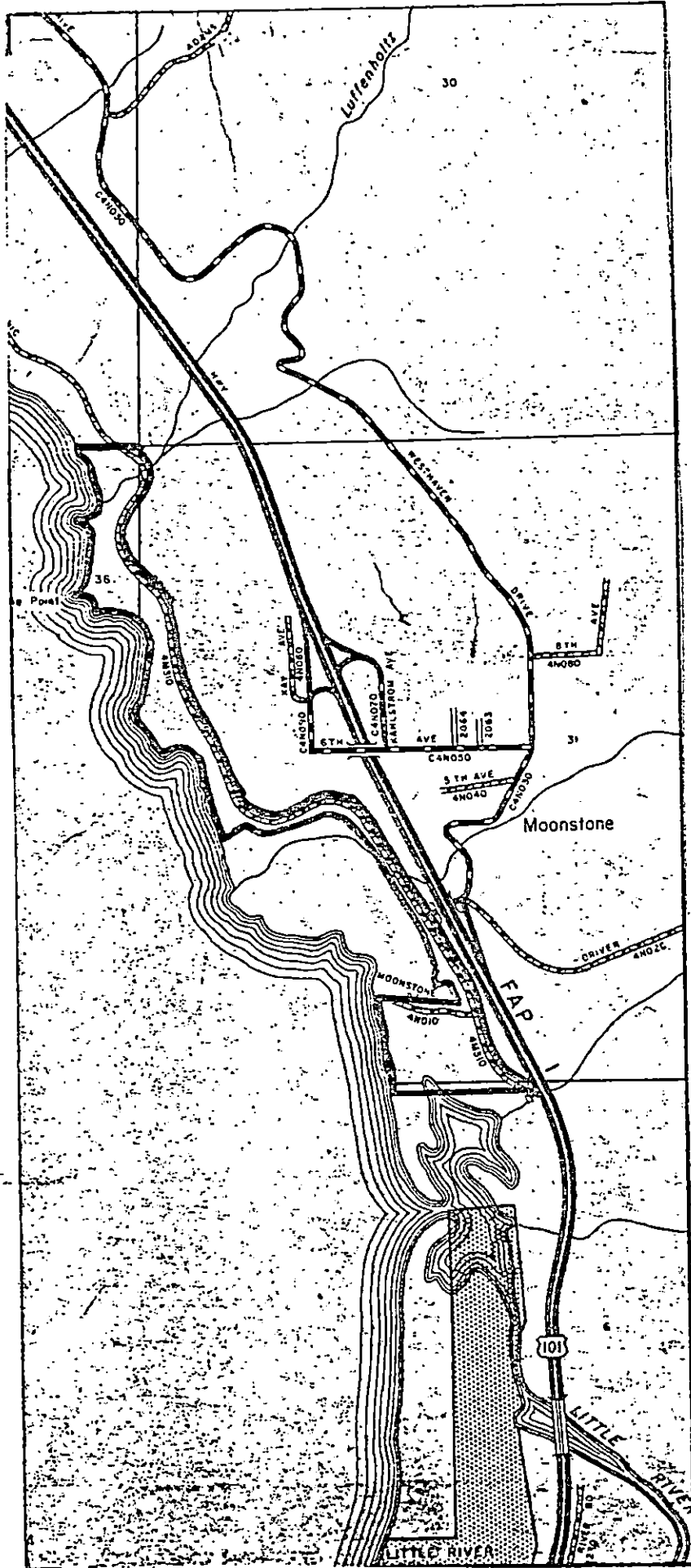
