

RESOLUTION NO. 91-82

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PICKETT ROAD UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1.

WHEREAS, by Board Order dated June 18, 1991, a public hearing was called for on July 16, 1991 and continued to July 30, 1991, at the hour of 1:45 p.m. in the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors office in the Courthouse, Eureka, California, to ascertain whether public necessity, health, safety, or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electricity, communications and similar or associated services, with that certain area of County described as follows: a wide corridor along each side of Pickett Road from Central Avenue to 135' west of Timothy Road;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt, pursuant to Ordinance No. 652 of the County of Humboldt, the above described area is hereby declared an Underground Utility District, and is designated as Pickett Road Underground Utility District No. 1 of the County of Humboldt, attached hereto marked Exhibit A, and hereby incorporated as a part of this Resolution is a map and legal description delineating the boundaries of said District;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors hereby sets December 15, 1991, as the date on which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service, and does hereby order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electricity, communications, and similar or associated services within the Pickett Road Underground Utility District No. 1 on or

before March 29, 1993;

WHEREAS, the County Clerk is hereby instructed to notify all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within the Pickett Road Underground Utility District No. 1 of the adoption of said Resolution. County Clerk shall further notify said property owners of the necessity that, if they or any persons occupying such property desire to continue to receive electricity, communications, and similar or associated services, they or such occupant shall, by the date fixed in this Resolution, provide all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive such services from the lines of the supplying utility or utilities at a new location, subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility or utilities on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. Such notification shall be made by mailing a copy of this Resolution, together with a copy of said Ordinance No. 652, to all affected property owners as such are shown on the last equalized assessment roll and to the affected utilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines as follows:

The Underground Utility District herein created is in the general public interest for the following reasons:

1. The undergrounding to be accomplished will avoid or eliminate an unusually heavy concentration of overhead distribution facilities.

2. The streets, roads or rights of way in the District are extensively used by the general public and carry a heavy volume of pedestrian or vehicular traffic.
3. The said streets, roads, or rights of way pass through an aesthetic area of interest to the general public.
4. The area has a substantial majority of property owners favoring undergrounding.

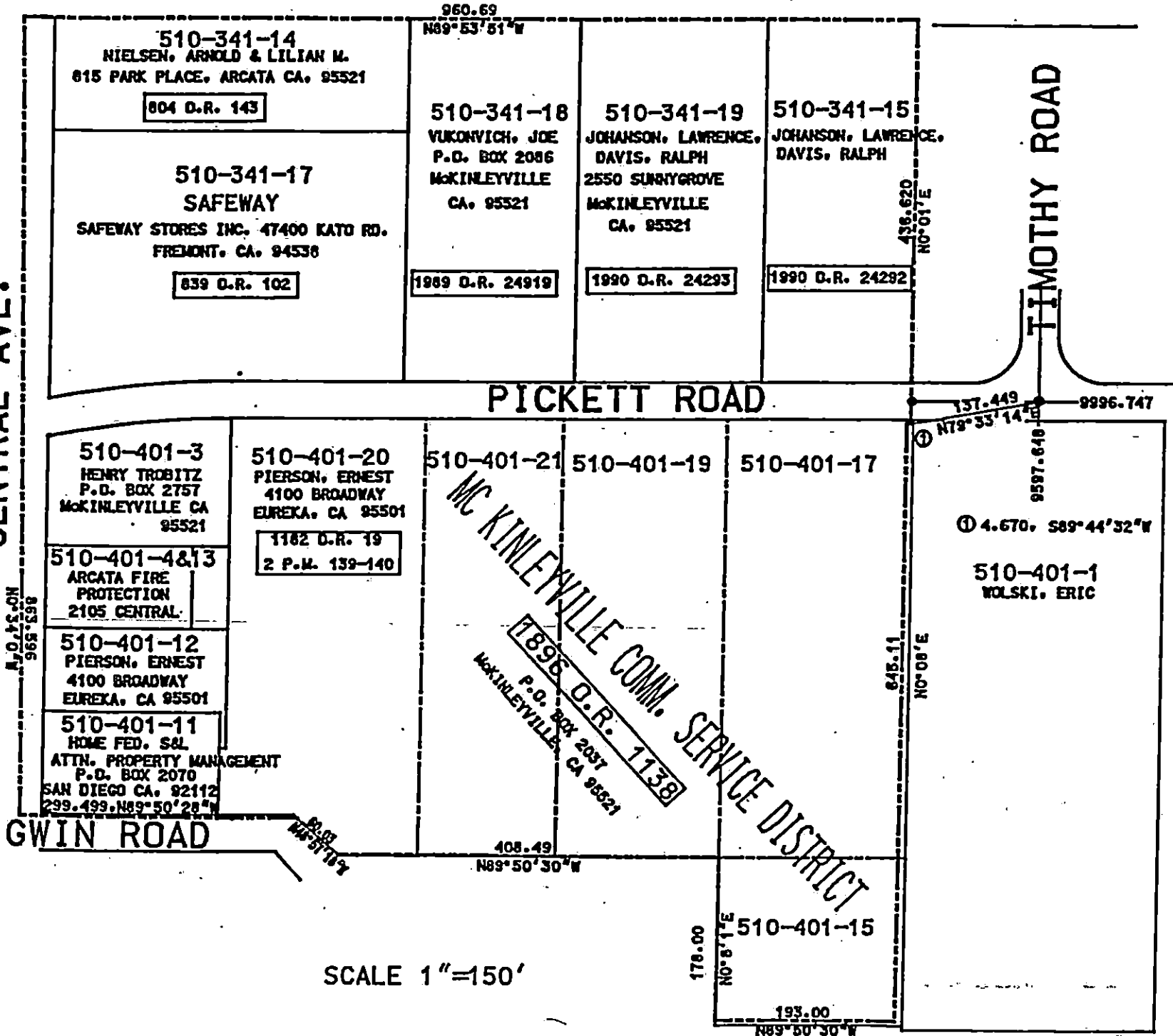

UTILITY DISTRICT DESCRIPTION

THIS DISTRICT LIES WITHIN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION
32 TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 1 EAST, HUMBOLDT BASE AND
MERIDIAN DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at the county road monument at the intersection of
Timothy and Pickett roads (recorded in Book 17 of Maps Pages
115-117); thence South $79^{\circ}33'14''$ West, 137.45 feet to the
point of beginning; thence South $89^{\circ}44'32''$ West 4.67 feet;
thence South $0^{\circ}08'$ West, 645.11 feet to the North right of
way line of Gwin road; thence North $89^{\circ}50'30''$ West, 193.00
feet; thence North $0^{\circ}08'$ East, 178.00 feet; thence North
 $89^{\circ}50'30''$ West, 408.49; thence North $48^{\circ}57'19''$ West, 60.03
feet; thence North $89^{\circ}50'30''$ West, 299.50 feet to the
section line running between sections 31 and 32; thence
North $0^{\circ}34'0''$ West, 863.60 feet to the Northwest corner of
that parcel of land described in book 804 of Official
Records page 143 ; thence South $89^{\circ}53'51''$ East, 960.69 feet
to the Northeast corner of that parcel of land as described
in Book 1990 of Official Records Page 24292; thence South
 $0^{\circ}01'$ West, 436.62 feet to the point of beginning.
