GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTIONS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all qualified voters that in accordance with the provisions of the Elections Code and Education Code of the State of California a general district election shall be held in the following school districts on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of electing members to the school district governing boards.

Candidates for the above office(s) shall be a registered voter residing in the school district and division in those cases where selection is by division. (Elections Code, Section 10602)

No person shall file nomination papers for more than one school district office, including county board of education, at the same election. (Elections Code, Section 10603(c))

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that declaration of candidacy forms are available at, and must be filed with, the Humboldt County Office of Elections, beginning on July 13, 2020, and no later than 5:00 pm on August 7, 2020. To request candidacy papers, candidates must complete and submit an Acknowledgement of Receipt of Instructions & Request for Candidacy Filing Documents form. The request form is available on the Humboldt County Office of Elections' website: <https://humboldt.gov/890/Elections-Voter-Registration>.

Upon receipt of the request form, the Office of Elections will distribute candidacy papers to the

candidate by (1) email, (2) mail, or (3) in person by appointment at the Office of Elections, per the method indicated on the request form. Candidates will not be charged a fee to file candidacy papers. Candidates may sign candidacy papers in the presence of a Notary Public or in person by appointment at the Office of Elections.

The Humboldt County Office of Elections is located at 2426 6th Street, in Eureka, California. Voters may contact the Humboldt County Office of Elections at 707-445-7481 or humboldt_elections@co.humboldt.ca.us to obtain information regarding filing for elective district offices. (Elections Code, Section 10510)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if a declaration of candidacy form from an incumbent member of a school district, community college district, or county board of education is not filed by 5:00 pm on the 88th day prior to the election, any qualified voter other than the incumbent shall have until 5:00 pm on the 83rd day prior to the election to file a declaration of candidacy for such elective office. (Elections Code, Sections 10407, 10603)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if by 5:00 pm on the 83rd day prior to the election only one person has been nominated for any elective school office, or no one has been nominated, or in the case of members to be elected from the district at large, the number of candidates for governing board members at large does not exceed the number of offices to be filled at that election, or in the case of members to be nominated by trustee area and elected at large, the number of candidates do not exceed the number required to be elected governing board member at large nominated by that trustee area, or in the case of members to be elected at large in accordance with the Education Code, no more than one person has been nominated for each membership, and petition signed by 10 percent of the voters or 50 voters whichever is the smaller number, in the district or trustee area, if elected by trustee area, requesting that a school district election be held for the office has not been presented to the Humboldt County Office of Elections, appointment will be made. (Education Code, Section 5328).
