

**NOTICE OF ELECTION  
NOTICE TO DECLARE CANDIDACY FOR SPECIAL DISTRICT  
DIRECTOR ELECTIONS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all qualified voters that in accordance with the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California, a general district election shall be held on November 2, 2021, for the purpose of electing members to the boards of the following districts:

Candidates for the above offices shall be registered to vote in Humboldt County and reside in the special district (and division in those cases where selection is by division). Additional qualifications of candidates may be determined by the principal act of each district. (Elections Code, Sections 10511, 10514)

No person shall file nomination papers for more than one special district office at the same election. (Elections Code, Section 10510(b))

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that declaration of candidacy forms are available at, and must be filed with, the Humboldt County Office of Elections, beginning on July 12, 2021, and no later than 5:00 pm on August 6, 2021. To request candidacy papers, candidates must complete and submit an Acknowledgement of Receipt of Instructions & Request for Candidacy Filing Documents form. The request form is available on the Humboldt County Office of Elections' website: <https://humboldt.gov.org/2900/Consolidated-Districts-Election---Novemb>.

Upon receipt of the request form, the Office of Elections will distribute candidacy papers to the candidate by (1) email, (2) mail, or (3) in person at the Office of Elections, per the method indicated on the request form. Candidates will not be charged a fee to file candidacy papers.

Candidates must sign candidacy papers either in the presence of a Notary Public or in person at the Office of Elections.

The Humboldt County Office of Elections is located at 2426 6th Street, in Eureka, California. Voters may contact the Humboldt County Office of Elections at 707-445-7481 or [humboldt\\_elections@co.humboldt.ca.us](mailto:humboldt_elections@co.humboldt.ca.us) to obtain information regarding filing for elective district offices. (Elections Code, Section 10510)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if a declaration of candidacy form from an incumbent member of a special district is not filed by 5:00 pm on the 88<sup>th</sup> day prior to the election, any qualified voter other than the incumbent shall have until 5:00 pm on the 83<sup>rd</sup> day prior to the election to file a declaration of candidacy for such elective office. (Elections Code, Sections 10407, 10516)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that appointment to each elective office will be made in the event that there are no candidates or an insufficient number of candidates to elective offices and a petition for an election is not filed with the County Office of Elections within the time prescribed. (Elections Code, Section 10515)
